С	Old School Lane is a right hand turn off of the Wellesbourne road out of
	the village, before the Church. The Cemetery is also up this lane.

F	third goes down the Manor's drive and through a gate in to a field.
G	Starts at a path between the last Hill Top property & the first Barracks

Friends of Loxley School


The FOLS are a group of parents and other interested adults who run regular fundraising events in aid of the school. These include:
